People, groups and organizations interested in or involved in activities related to creative positive changes in their communities are invited to a regional forum to share their ideas.

There has been a lot of discussion about how our lives will be impacted by peak oil and climate change and a lot of energy has gone into sustainability planning. We would like to move on from there to focus on the actions that groups are planning and undertaking to move towards creating localized, resilient communities. The purpose of this forum is to network with others in the region, to share the ideas and projects and look for ways to work together regionally to make our efforts more effective and our voices louder and stronger.

In the morning, Tamara Sunsong from Victoria's Transition Town group will review the Transition Town model of change and share with us the work the Victoria TT group is undertaking. Tamara has been part of the Initiating Committee of Transition Victoria since it started in early 2009, and is an active member of the economics and food working groups, acting as co-facilitator of the food group until recently. This session will provide an opportunity to explore the usefulness of this process for our own communities and help us decide whether there is enough interest to bring the Transition Town training to our region.

In the afternoon we are inviting groups to make short presentations about the projects they are involved with. There will be an opportunity for groups to sharing ideas about ways we can work together at the regional level. We are hoping that groups will also bring resources that they can share. We are asking each person to contribute \$20 in order to cover the cost of bringing Tamara to our gathering and the cost of the venue. We are also asking that everyone bring a bag lunch to help contain costs.
